#### Creates two pay schedules - Grandfather and Performance



#### **Grandfather Salary**

Schedule allows teachers to earn higher salaries sooner and at a higher percentage (2014-2015)



#### **Performance-based**

Schedule (2015-2016) requires Highly Effective or Effective summative ratings on student achievement for increases
